WHAT IS TIKTOK?

A QUICK OVERVIEW

TikTok is a social media platform that allows you to create and watch short videos between 15 and 60 seconds long. It's mainly known for dance and lip synching videos.

ACCOUNT PRIVACY

PROFILE/ME > THREE VERTICAL DOTS > PRIVACY AND SAFETY > TOGGLE 'PRIVATE ACCOUNT'

When you turn your TikTok account to private, only people you have approved can follow you can view your content, and TikTok will stop syncing with other apps.



BLOCKING PROFILES

SELECT THEIR PROFILE > THREE DOTS > BLOCK > CONFIRM

Blocking people's profiles stops them from viewing or interacting with any part of your profile and content. If you are blocking someone for bullying or being inappropriate, it's recommended you also report them.

REPORTING PROFILES

SELECT THEIR PROFILE > THREE DOTS > REPORT > SELECT REASON

When you report a profile your report will be sent to the TikTok moderators, who will then review it and if it is violating their terms of use the offending profile will be terminated.



REPORTING CONTENT

VIDEOS AND COMMENTS

Reporting videos: open video > tap 'share' arrow > select report > select the reason. Offending videos will be removed. Reporting comments: tap and hold comment > select 'report' select reason.
