• Always walk around in big groups - in between lessons you can join in conversations, but also getting lost will be a lot more enjoyable if you are not on your own!

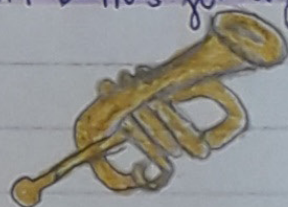
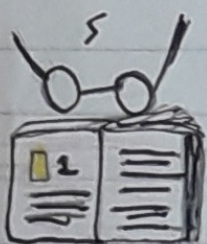
• Do not carry all of your books in your bag, only carry the ones you need that day!
